If you have done what the Bible says you must do, then you may claim the promises that are in the Word of God — as long as you fulfil the condition of each promise.

The Gospel Sets You Free

The good news is God's news to you. If you have accepted the free gift of salvation that comes through the blood of Jesus, then you can "Know that you are in Him." (1 John 2:5) When you read all the wonderful promises God makes to His children, remember: "These things have I written that you may know that **you have eternal life.**" (1 John 5:13)

Read: If the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed. — **Joh 8:36**

Assurance is Threefold

- 1. In your mind** you can be sure of salvation because you know what has happened to you and you can read what the Word of God tells you. "We know that we passed out of death into life."
- 2. In God's heart** you are a new creation. The Holy Spirit dwells in your soul as his deposit and seal. Your name is written in the Book of Life of the Lamb. God can see Jesus in you.
- 3. In the eyes of the world** your life has changed, witnessing of a newborn spirit. The fruit of the Holy Spirit in you changes your character gradually and it can be seen by everyone you meet.

You have Acted on the Gospel

You will never forget the day you did this, nor will God.

⇒ **Have you taken the following steps?**

- 1. CONFESS** – I know that I am a sinner at heart
- 2. REPENT** – I have turned my back on sin
- 3. BELIEVE** – Jesus is the Saviour, Son of God
- 4. RECEIVE** – I receive Him as my Lord and Saviour

Tick each one of the blocks if you have full assurance. This will help you to have peace in your heart that the writing that was against you has been wiped out. All your sins are forgiven and you have eternal life!
